Urban Adventures – the coolest way to see a city

Urban Adventures are interactive city tours with a mobile phone for your guide. You can play alone, or compete **against** other teams.

There are games for everyone! Tourists have fun as they visit the **main attractions**. Local people discover new things in their town or city. There are games for families, school groups, and birthday parties, too!

Urban Adventures has something for everyone!

How it works
You need comfortable shoes and a mobile phone with a camera. You receive text messages with directions on your mobile phone. Go to the starting point, then follow the instructions. You must complete **challenges**. These challenges ask you to find things, solve **puzzles**, or take crazy photos. Games take two to three hours.

Rules
Can anyone play the games? Yes, but there are a few simple rules:

- 1 You must buy your tickets on our website.
- 2 Everyone in a group must have a ticket.
- 3 Children must be with an adult.
- 4 You mustn't use a car or a motorbike.
- 5 You mustn't enter private buildings.

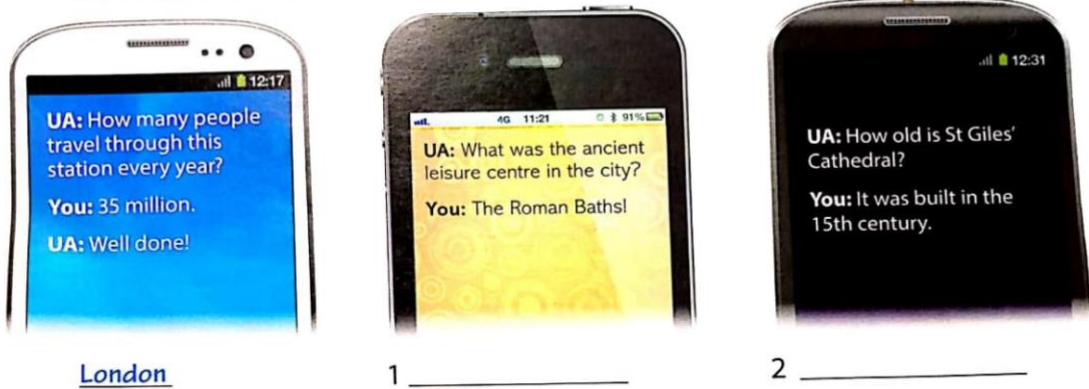
